Take advantage of a simple system which allows tax to be reclaimed on all your donations to your parish via Gift Aid.

This means for every £1 you give, the parish gets an extra 25p back from the government. There is no charge to you, nor any extra tax for you to pay.

If you're already paying tax on wages, salaries, pensions or income/capital gains from investments, the Government simply gives back to the Church some of the tax you have already paid.

We do not need to know income, nor details such as your National Insurance number.

#### To get the taxman giving to your parish is simple.

All you have to do is complete and return to your parish the 'declaration' overleaf. There is also a form you can fill in if you wish to donate by standing order (preferred), or you can ask your parish for a box of envelopes.
