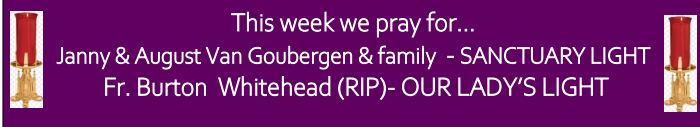

Anyone wishing to Gift Aid please let us know and we will forward a form to you. For every £1 you donate parish will receive 25p extra if you pay tax. All you need to do is sign a form, we do the rest.

From the new financial year in April we will no longer be providing Gift Aid envelopes, we would like to encourage everyone who currently uses envelopes to set up standing orders. Whether you are able to Gift Aid or not you can set up a Standing Order or transfer by BACS using these details: NatWest Bank. Account No: 02342731; Sort Code: 51 70 15.

Offering Envelopes will to be provided to all parishioners via the bulletin for Easter Sunday and Christmas Day collections as these will continue to be our traditional offerings to our Parish Priests.

100 CLUB: Renewals for the next 12 months are due from 1 April with the first draw in the new financial year taking place on Sunday, 25 April. The annual fee remains at £60, payable in full by cheque or monthly standing order.
