This weekend's Liturgy of the Word: Today we will hear again Christ's immortal parable about a man lying wounded by the roadside, and how two people passed him by while a third stopped and helped him. Let us stop for a moment and call to mind the number of times we have passed by someone who needed help.

First Reading (Deut. 30: 10-14). Moses urges the people to obey God's law, not as something imposed from outside them, but as something that springs up from inside themselves.

Second Reading (Colossians I: 15-20). Paul asserts the absolute supremacy of Christ. He is the beginning and end of creation, the head of the Church, and the universal mediator and redeemer. Gospel (Luke 10:25-37). This relates Christ's immortal parable of the Good Samaritan.


