### 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading (Isaiah 49:3.5-6) The prophet sees himself as God's servant, chosen to bring Israel back to God, and not just Israel, but all people.

Second Reading (1 Cor 1: 1-3). This contains Paul's rich opening greeting to his converts at Corinth.

Gospel (John 1:29-34) St John the Baptist presents Jesus as God's Chosen Servant who will take away the sins of the people and renew them in the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel of today's Mass, John the Baptist points out Jesus to the people as the long-awaited Saviour. Jesus came to take away our sins. He came to heal our wounds. He came to renew us through the Holy Spirit.
