We have seen a difficult start to 2021, the virus is spreading at an unprecedented rate. The number of cases and the number of deaths is alarmingly high and we find ourselves in yet another lockdown. Let us keep all who have been affected in our thoughts and prayers. However, we must be grateful for the good news that the vaccine will be available to more and more people, especially those who are vulnerable and health care workers. Further to the announcement of the new lockdown by the Prime Minister, Places of Worship are able to continue to be open. Thankfully, we are well and able to return to celebrate Mass. However, due to a significant Covid increase in our area we have reduced the number of public Masses and also reduced the number of attendees able to attend. Do not come if symptomatic or self-isolating. Sunday obligation remains suspended and live-stream Masses will continue. Please refer to the bulletin for our Mass times if you are able to attend. We have to continue to comply with the Governments very strict safety regulations and we must do all we can to keep everybody safe in church. Masks are compulsory and we ask that you register for Track and Trace as you enter. You must observe social distancing at all times, and tempting as it is, you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when you attend Mass. Thank you to those who clean and steward our churches for their generosity of service to the local community, and thank you for your cooperation and understanding in these difficult times. NHS TRACK AND TRACE APP If you have a smart phone, please register using our QR codes in both of our churches when you attend. The codes are on display as you enter. Anyone who does not have a smartphone can provide their contact details at the entrance to the stewards.
