# This Weekend's Liturgy of the Word:

Today we begin the Church's liturgical year. This gives us a chance to make a fresh start. Advent is not a time for sleep. Today's readings urge us to wake up. Let us begin by asking the Lord's forgiveness and help

<u>First Reading</u> (Isaiah 2:1-5). With its vision of universal peace, this reading is surely one of the most inspiring in the Bible. But it also challenges Christians to work for this new world which was inaugur-ated by Christ.

**Second Reading** (Romans 13: 11-14). St Paul urges us to wake up; to turn away from the darkness of evil, and to walk in the light of Christ.

*Gospel* (Matthew 24:37-44). This Gospel urges us to stay awake because we do not know the day or the hour when Christ will return.


