### WHO CAN RECEIVE BAPTISM?

1246 "Every person not yet baptized and only such a person is able to be baptized."46

The Baptism of adults: 1247 Since the beginning of the Church, adult Baptism is the common practice where the proclamation of the Gospel is still new. The catechumenate (preparation for Baptism) therefore occupies an important place. This initiation into Christian faith and life should dispose the catechumen to receive the gift of God in Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.

1248 The catechumenate, or formation of catechumens, aims at bringing their conversion and faith to maturity, in response to the divine initiative and in union with an ecclesial community. The catechumenate is to be "a formation in the whole Christian life . .

. during which the disciples will be joined to Christ their teacher. The catechumens should be properly initiated into the mystery of salvation and the practice of the evangelical virtues, and they should be introduced into the life of faith, liturgy, and charity of the People of God by successive sacred rites."47

1249 Catechumens "are already joined to the Church, they are already of the household of Christ, and are quite frequently already living a life of faith, hope, and charity."48 "With love and solicitude mother Church already embraces them as her own."49

birth in Baptism to be freed from the power of darkness and brought into the realm of the freedom of the children of God, to which all men are called.50 The sheer gratuitousness of the grace of salvation is particularly manifest in infant Baptism. The Church and the parents would deny a child the priceless grace of becoming a child of God were they not to confer Baptism shortly after birth.51

1251 Christian parents will recognize that this practice also accords with their role as nurturers of the life that God has entrusted to them.52

1252 The practice of infant Baptism is an immemorial tradition of the Church. There is explicit testimony to this practice from the second century on, and it is quite possible that, from the beginning of the apostolic preaching, when whole "households" received baptism, infants may also have been baptized.53 (to continue) (Catechism of the Catholic Church)

HOLY SOULS ENVELOPES: November is traditionally the month particularly set aside for prayers for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, especially for the deceased members of our families and for those who are without family to pray for them. Please take an envelope from the back of the Church, write the name(s) of those for whom you wish to prayed, place an offering in the envelope and hand it to Priests/Sisters/Stewards or place it in the casket.

**PIETY SHOP:** Although currently closed, orders can be placed via email to the parish office and collected and paid for at Mass times or by arrangement. Grave lights now in stock. Unfortunately, no new Christmas stock will be ordered this year. We do however, have a limited supply from last year: Boxed & individual Christmas cards, advent candles, children's books, olive tree decorations and other gifts. Items can be seen through the shop windows, and some images online.

**GUIDELINES FOR PARISHIONERS** When the Mass starts, the doors of the Church will be locked so please try to come early. Please make sure that you follow the instructions of the stewards and all signage that is in place. If you arrive for Mass and you do not have a face covering you will not be allowed entrance (unless you are asthmatic or under 5). The celebrant will be obliged to stop Mass if this obligation is ignored. Please be aware that the Church will be closed after each Mass and there are no toilet facilities available. Offerings/ Donations can be placed in the casket/collection box at the entrance or exit. We provide a separate Lectern for the reader. All Lectors please sanitize your hands before and after. Do not congregate either inside or outside of church before or at the end of Mass. Please maintain silence before and after Mass. The social distance of 1m Plus must be observed at all times, including before and after Mass. NHS TRACK AND TRACE APP If you have a smart phone, please register using our QR codes in both of our churches when you attend Mass. The codes are on display as you enter. Anyone who does not have a smartphone can provide their contact details at the entrance.
