
ASH WEDNESDAY: 2nd March 2022, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent, which is observed everywhere as a fast day. I would like to invite you to participate in a fruitful way in the Lenten liturgies and penitential celebrations. As you know that Lent is ordered to preparing for the celebration of Easter, since the Lenten liturgy prepares for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery both Catechumens, by various stages of Christian Initiation and the faithful, who recall their own baptism and do penance.
