

READY, STEADY, CENSUS The decennial census is almost upon us. Households across Bicester will soon be asked to take part in the nation-wide survey of housing and the population. It has been carried out every decade since 1801, with the exception of 1941. Information from the digital-first census will help decide how services are planned and funded in your local area. This could mean things like doctors' surgeries, housing or new bus routes. Households will receive a letter with a unique access code in the post, allowing them to complete their questionnaire online. Paper questionnaires will be available on request. **Census day is March 21**. For more information, visit census.gov.uk.

PARISH FINANCES Every parish is struggling financially at the moment, and we are no different. As we approach the end of the financial year I would like to thank you all for your continued financial support to our parishes, especially during the past, incredibly difficult year. Both parishes have run at a deficit this year, particularly the Parish of The Immaculate Conception where we have carried out some building works (presbytery chimney, kitchen, bathrooms and the sacristy roof). From January 2021, the levies that every parish pays to the Archdiocese (for curial support etc) have increased substantially. I intend to speak about this, and the impact it will have on our parishes in the coming weeks. We have also come to the decision, that as of April 2021 we will cease to use the Gift Aid 'envelopes' due to the ever decreasing number of parishioners opting for them. We will be contacting the small number of parishioners who are currently registered users of them directly, regarding this, in due course.

In the meantime I would like to encourage you to consider if:

- + you might be able to Gift Aid your donations? If you are a UK taxpayer, we can claim an extra 25p for every £1 you give at no extra cost to you!
- + you could sign up to a Standing Order rather than using cash? Finally, thank you, once again for your continued support.
