This Weekend's Liturgy of the Word:



We are getting very close to Christmas, and the pace of things getting busier. There are so many things calling for our time and attention. The result could be that the spiritual side of Christmas hardly gets a look in. Let us pause to make room in our minds and hearts so that Christ may come to us during this Mass.



First Reading (Isaiah 7: 10- I 4). This reading foretells the birth of a very special child - a child who will be called Emmanuel, God-with-us.

Second Reading (Romans I: 1-7). This contains the opening lines from St Paul's letter to the Christians at Rome. In them he refers to the human and divine 'roots' of Christ.

Gospel (Matthew 1: 18-25). Joseph, the just man is told that Mary's child was conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit and the mission of this child is to save his people from their sins.






