Reflections briefly on this weekend's Word of God '

3rd Sunday in ordinary Time

First Reading (Isaiah 8:23-9:3). The prophet predicts future glory for an oppressed people: light will replace darkness; joy will replace sorrow; and freedom will replace oppression.



Second Reading (1 Cor 1: 10-13.17) This shows that even among the first Christians there were divisions. But Paul urges unity in Christ.

Gospel (Matthew 4: 12-23) That wonderful prophecy of Isaiah is seen as being fulfilled in Christ. St Matthew describes Christ's mission like this: 'The people who lived in darkness have seen a great light'. We too live in a world darkened by violence, injustice, hatred, war, and death. We desperately need the light of Christ, both in our individual lives and in the world as a whole.
