This Weekend's Liturgy of the Word:

Today's Gospel tells about the cure of a man born blind. We all suffer from different forms of blindness. Our sins are a form of blindness. We all have many blind spots. But there is hope for us if we are willing to admit them.

First Reading (I Samuel 16:1, 6-7,10-13). God chose David the least of Jesse's sons, to be king of Israel. This shows that, whereas people look at appearances, God looks at the heart.

Second Reading (Ephesians 5:8-14). Paul tells the Christians at Ephesus that once they were in darkness but now Christ has en-lightened them. Therefore, they must adopt a lifestyle which is appropriate to their new state.

Gospel (John 9: 1-41). Jesus is the light of the world. He not only gives sight to those who are physically blind, but the light of faith to those who are spiritually blind, provided they are open to receive it.

Let us pray for all those who are suffering with COVID-19 and for all Key Workers who are taking care of the sick, the elderly and also for those who are ensuring that we have sufficient food and other essentials available.
