This weekend's Liturgy of the Word: First Reading (Amos 8:4-7). Amos was a great champion of social justice. In this short reading he depicts the 'religious' employers waiting impatiently for the Sabbath to end so that they can get on with their lucrative but dishonest trading.

Second Reading (I Tim 2: 1-8). Paul urges Christians to pray for everyone, especially those who hold public office, because God wants everyone to be saved.

Gospel (Luke 16:1-13). This contains the parable of the astute steward who used his ill-gotten money to gain admittance into people's homes. Christ says we can learn something from him. There is no doubt but that the so-called 'good life' (money, comfort, success, pleasure) exercises an enormous pull on us all. We want to serve God but we do not want our service of him to interfere with our habits, our impulses, our way of life. Today's Gospel tells us that we cannot serve God and money at the same time. Let us examine ourselves for a moment to see where our loyalties lie.
