

David had already been anointed king of Judah. Here we read how the northern tribes also acknowledge him as king. Thus David became the king of a united country

Second Reading (Colossians 1:11-20). Paul gives thanks to God for having delivered us from the dominion of darkness and transferred us to the Kingdom of his Son, who is not only head of the Church but head of all creation.

Gospel (Luke 23:35-43). This tells of the mockery Christ suffered as he hung on the cross, and how in the midst of it he brought hope and salvation (0 one of the thieves crucified with him.
