'Word of God'

First Reading (Isaiah 49: 14-15): The message of this is short and sweet. It is that, come what may, God will never forget us.

Second Reading $|I \operatorname{Cor} 4: I-5|$: God is the only one who can judge rightly, because he alone knows the secrets of the heart.

Gospel (Matthew 6:24-34): Christ urges us to avoid useless frett-ing and worrying about material things, and to place our lives in the hands of our heavenly Father, to whom we are important and precious.
