#### **COVID Restrictions Update**

As you will be aware the current lockdown is due to end on the  $2^{nd}$  December. I have now received guidelines that confirm that communal worship will be able to restart from the  $2^{nd}$  Dec in all Local Restriction Tiers. I attach a table with the relevant information. Effectively this is a return to the COVID-secure principles that existed in our churches as at the  $5^{th}$  November. The decision of the government to allow communal worship in all tiers is in recognition of the importance of what takes place in our churches and of our active collaboration in creating safe environments in our buildings. It is, therefore, important to emphasise that applications of good practice and the encouragement of people to engage fully with what is asked of them must continue. Details of which tier will apply in which area is due to be announced on Thursday of this week.
