This Weekend's Liturgy of the Word: In today's Gospel we see a scene which is all too common in our own world - people weeping over the death of a loved one. Jesus is at the heart of this sad scene, for it is his good friend Lazarus who is dead. In the midst of the darkness Jesus shines the light of hope. He tells Lazarus' sisters that those who believe in him never really die. He says the same to us.

First Reading (Ezekiel 37:12-14). The exile of the people to Babylon is described in terms of death. And their return home is described in terms of resurrection and spiritual renewal.

Second Reading (Romans 8: 8-11). It was the Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead. Now this same Spirit lives in us. Therefore, we have no need to be afraid of death.

Gospel (John 11: 1-45) By raising his friend Lazarus from the dead, Jesus shows that he is Lord of life and death.

Let us pray for all those who are suffering with COVID-19 and for all Key Workers who are taking care of the sick, the elderly and also for those who are ensuring that we have sufficient food and other essentials available.

REDEDICATION OF ENGLAND TO OUR LADY: Rededication of England to Our Lady will take place during livestream Mass on Sunday 29th March.

100 Club renewals for the next 12 months are due from 1 April with the first draw in the new financial year taking place on Sunday, 26 April. 
PRAYER FOR HEALTH STAFF
