This Weekend's Liturgy of the Word: Today's Gospel is a shocking one, at least it shocked the people of Christ's time. How often we do what will make us popular, rather than what is right. We go where we will be most welcome, rather than where we are most needed. We befriend those who are kind of us, and ignore those we don't like.

First Reading (Wisdom 11:22-12:2). It was out of love that God created the world in the first place. Therefore he does not desire the destruction or death of the human family, but is always ready to pardon the sins of those who

Second Reading (2 Thess 1: 11-2:2). Paul urges the Thessalonians to be worthy of their call and assures them that God will help them to be true to it. At the same time he tells them that the second coming of Christ has not yet taken place.

Gospel (Luke 19:1-10). This relates the conversion of a rich tax collector by the name of Zacchaeus.

Monday Films continue on Monday 4th November after the 9.30 am Mass. We will show the third part of Bishop Barron's film The Mystery


