ReflectionsPENTECOST SUNDAY

First Reading (Acts 2: I-II). This describes the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles and the effect of this on them.

Second Reading (1 Cor 12:3-7,12-13). Paul says that each of us has been given different gifts by the Holy Spirit. These gifts are given, not just for our own good, but for the

good of the Church, the Body of Christ.

Gospel (John 20: 19-23). On Easter Day the risen Jesus came to his disciples, breathed the Holy Spirit upon them, and then commissioned them as messengers of God's peace and forgiveness.

This is the day when Jesus, true to his promise, sent his Spirit on the apostles. The coming of the Spirit resulted in changed people and saw the launching of the new community, the Church. This great day renews the gift of the Spirit in each of us and in the Church as a whole. Let us pause to dispose ourselves to receive the Spirit.
