Latest guidance

Baptism: – 30 people at a stand-alone celebration.

Marriage - 30 people.

Funerals - capacity of church (80 People)

<u>Holy Communion</u> remains under one kind. Communion on the tongue allowed, but those who wish to receive in that way should wait until the end of communion and hands should be sanitised.

Face masks continue to be worn.

<u>Sanitising hands</u> on entry to churches and before liturgies as in current church guidance reduces risk.

<u>Singing:</u> Indoor, congregational singing remains prohibited although small group singing is allowed, if essential, limited to groups of no more than 6.

<u>Catechetical Groups</u> - may resume.

<u>Servers and Assistants:</u> Those needed for the celebration of Mass <u>Holy Water Stoups</u>: Unfilled

Let us not be too casual in following the guidelines. For everyone's safety, let us continue to follow the COVID guidelines.

We use live streaming to enable

- Housebound parishioners to engage with mass from home
- Relatives/friends who cannot attend a baptism/ wedding/funeral to engage with it
- The tabernacle to be used as a focus for prayer for those who cannot get to church
- Evangelisation: -enabling those who cannot or do not attend church for any reason to engage with acts of worship

All of these reasons are necessary in the legitimate interests of the church. The images are made available live over the internet, and can be accessed by anyone who wishes to do so .

Live streaming is carried out during services and a camera focussed on the sanctuary may be live streaming all the time. There is no public access to the sanctuary area.
