THURSDAY, 11TH FEBRUARY 1858 - FIRST MEETING:

Accompanied by her sister and a friend, Bernadette went to Massbielle on the banks of the Gave to collect bones and dead wood. Removing her socks in order to cross the stream, she heard a noise like a gust of wind, she looked up towards to Grotto: "I saw a lady dressed in white, she wore a white dress, and equally white veils, a blue belt and a yellow rose on each feet". Bernadette made the sign of the cross and said the rosary with the lady. When the prayer ended, the Lady suddenly vanished.
