

Today we begin the week we call 'Holy Week' - the week in which Christ died and rose. He died because of sin. 'Sin brought death to the Son of God and it continues to bring death to the children of God.' (Oscar Romero).

Gospel for Procession (Luke 19:28-40). Christ enters Jerusalem to receive a kingdom - not an earthly kingdom, but the kingdom of God. His entry as messianic King is a sign that the peace and salvation decreed by God is at hand. We are asked to declare our loyalty publicly

First Reading (Isaiah 50:4-7). The prophet suffers in carrying out his mission, but he is convinced that God will eventually save him. Second Reading (Philippians 2:6-11). Because Jesus took on himself our human condition and accepted death on a cross, the Father has made him Lord of heaven and earth.

Gospel (Luke 22: 14-23:56). Luke's version of the Passion Story. As in the rest of his Gospel, so in his account of the Passion, St Luke presents a Christ who is merciful and forgiving, even to his executioners. We are involved in the Passion Story too.
