<u>Reflections</u>

First Reading (Acts 2:42-47): Jesus said: 'By their fruits you shall know them'. The first Christians showed the depth of their faith by the fruits they produced in their lives.

Second Reading (I Peter 1:3-9): We base our hope of eternal glory on the resurrection of Christ from the dead. This hope helps us to bear patiently the trials of life.

Gospel (John 20:19-31): By touching the wounds of the risen Jesus, Thomas' doubt was turned into faith. In today's Gospel we meet Doubting Thomas. Each of us has something in common with him, for at times our minds are darkened by doubt. The risen Jesus is with us now, and he says to us what he said to Thomas: 'Cease doubting and believe.'
