Today's Word:

First Reading (Acts 9:26-31). This tells how Barnabas introduced the converted Paul to the Christians living in Jerusalem. They accepted him but the Jews tried to kill him.

Second Reading (I John 3: 18-24). If we wish to live as God wants, we must keep his commandments, especially the commandment to love one another. Gospel (John 15: 1-8). Christ uses the image of a vine and its branches to illustrate the closeness of the ties that exist between him and his disciples. There is no such thing as a solitary Christian. Every Christian is linked to Christ and to all other Christians by an invisible bond. This bond is very precious. It was Christ who wished it, and it was he who best described it. He said: "I am the vine, you are the branches". Alas, we often live as if this bond never existed. We live for ourselves. We ignore and sometimes even hurt each other.
