<u>Reflections</u>



First Reading (Acts 2:14;22-28): This is part of a sermon preached by Peter to the Jews on the feast of Pentecost. It shows that the resurrection of Jesus from the dead is the very heart of the Good News.

Second Reading (I Peter 1:17-21): The benefits we enjoy as Christians were won by Christ through the shedding of his blood. We must try to respond with a life of holiness.

Cospel (Luke 24: 13-35): This contains the story of two men whose dreams had been shattered when Jesus was executed, how the risen Jesus joined them and showed them that it was by dying that he entered his glory.

On Easter Sunday evening two disciples of Jesus were returning to their native village. They were filled with sadness because the man on whom they had pinned their hopes had been executed. Then the risen Jesus joined them, opened their eyes, and turned their sadness into joy. The risen Jesus stands among us as we gather in his name to celebrate the Eucharist. He will turn our sorrows into joy.
