Scriptural Reflections

First Reading (Isaiah 22: 19-23): This reading talks about one man being dismissed from his high office, and the keys of authority being passed to another.

Second Reading (Romans 11:33-36): This contains a hymn of joyful praise to the wisdom of God, which is far too deep for us to fathom.

Gospel (Matthew 16: 13-20): Peter makes a marvelous declaration of faith in Christ, and Christ tells him that he will give him the keys of the Kingdom of heaven.

In today's liturgy we will look at Peter, the man Christ chose to be the chief shepherd of his flock. We will see Peter's ups and downs, his strengths and weaknesses, as well as the love Christ showed him which helped him to grow. We all have weaknesses. We all deny Christ just as Peter did. But Christ forgives us and helps us go forward again. Lord believed in Peter even when he didn't believe in himself. Lord confronted Peter with his failure to stay awake with you in the garden. Lord forgave him generously, and trusted him again, after he had denied you three times.
