Scriptural Reflections

The transfiguration of Jesus is prefigured in the first reading. Daniel's vision describes a royal investiture of a human king before God's throne. The *Son of Man* is a Messianic title for God's anointed King, the Lord Jesus Christ. God sent us his Son not to



establish an earthly kingdom but to bring us into his heavenly kingdom - a kingdom ruled by truth, justice, peace, and holiness.

In the second reading, Peter bears a first hand, and an eye witness testimony about the glory Christ revealed to him and his colleagues. Confidently, he proclaims: "We have seen his majesty ourselves." It is, in order that we ourselves might believe. It is in order that we might know, that we shall share in this same glory of Christ. It is also, that we might persevere.

In the gospel, Jesus took three of his disciples to the top of a mountain. There, he revealed a glimpse of his glory to them. Glorified with him were, Moses (the law giver), and Elijah (the great prophet). They were glorified with Christ because they overcame. It was also a sign that the Old Testament was not completely forgotten. Their efforts were not in vain. So, they share in the glory of Christ. We shall also share in the same glory, if we overcome.
