## LITURGY OF THE WORD - REFLECTION\$ IN BRIEF:

'Treat others (even your enemies) as you would like them to treat you.' These words are taken from today's Gospel. We know exactly how we like others to treat us: we like them to be forgiving, merciful, generous and loving towards us. But how many of us could say that we treat others in that way?

In this Gospel Christ is asking us to be totally open, not just to our friends, but to all, even our enemies. A tall order surely? This openness calls for a large measure of defenselessness. It's easy, by adopting a vindictive attitude, to become poisoned by selfishness, hatred and fear. Hate robs us of so much. Whereas love awakens in us extraordinary energies and helps us to do what we thought we were incapable of. But is it possible, is it even desirable, to love someone who intends us evil?
