LITURGY OF THE WORD - REFLECTION\$ IN BRIEF:

First Reading (Jeremiah 1:4-5, 17-19). Jeremiah was one of the greatest prophets God sent among his people. This reading tells of his call by God and of his commission as a prophet.



Second Reading (I Cor 12:31-13:13). This contains Paul's great hymn in praise of love. He says that for a follower of Christ love is by far the most important virtue of all.

Gospel (Luke 4:21-30). This tells how Jesus shared the fate of every true prophet: he was rejected by his own people. In the Gospel of today's Mass we read of the extraordinary incident in which Jesus was chased out of his native village of Nazareth. Why? Because they couldn't take the truth he was telling them. None of us has any great desire to hear the truth, especially when it exposes unpleasant things about ourselves. We too reject the messengers God sends to us. Let us think about that for a moment.
