Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord

*First Reading* (Isaiah 60: 1-6) The exiles returned from Babylon to find Jerusalem in ruins. The prophet cheers them up with a vision of a restored city. Her scattered children will return, and numerous strangers will come there to worship the true God.

**Second Reading** (Ephesians 3:2-3.5-6) Paul reveals the truth that God invites all, both Jew and Gentile, to share on an equal footing the salvation brought by Christ.

**Gospel** (Matthew 2:1-12). This tells how three strangers came from a far country to pay homage to the Christ-child, while the Jewish leaders rejected him.

Today we hear once again the story of the wise men who embarked on a long and hazardous journey in search of the Christ-child. What made them wise? It was the fact that, whereas his own people didn't want to know him, they recognised this Child as the Saviour of the world. What led us here this morning? What does Christ mean to us?
