**Second Reading** (Ephesians 4: 1-6). St Paul pleads with the Ephesians to live a life in keeping with the Gospel. He stresses the need for unity and harmony.

**Gospel** (John 6: 1-15). Like Elisha Jesus feeds the people miraculously. However, the people misunderstand the meaning of this event.



## WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES 21-26 AUGUST 2018

### BANBURY DEANERY PETITION BOX

WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES takes place in Dublin in August with Pope Francis. The theme is 'The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World.' The Archdiocese is sending 100 representatives who will take petitions from all who wish to write one and hopefully present them in the final Mass to his Holiness. In just over 3 weeks time Archbishop Bernard will accompany over 100 pilgrims, made up of 20 sponsored families from across the Diocese, to Dublin for the World Meeting of Families. For us all to be part of the preparations for this event there has been a petition box travelling round our deanery collecting petitions which will be taken to Dublin and presented to Pope Francis at the closing Mass. The petition box is with us until this Sunday 29th, after this time petitions can be emailed to Lianne Pap (Diocesan Family Ministry Worker) - [lianne.pap@rc-birmingham.org](mailto:lianne.pap@rc-birmingham.org) by August 19th. Petitions can be for yourself, family, friends or for anyone who may be in need of prayers.

## Safeguarding in the Archdiocese of Birmingham: SCIE Review

Archbishop Bernard Longley has commissioned a review of our current safeguarding/child protection practices in light of the National Catholic Policies and Procedures. This review is to be welcomed as a means of ensuring that our systems to protect our children and young people are as effective as possible. This review is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence). As part of the review, SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese, and have experience of working with our parish safeguarding representatives and the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese.
