

First Reading (Eze.17:22-24). The prophet foretells the downfall of Jerusalem. At the same time he tells of a restoration that will be brought about by a member of the chosen people (namely, the Messiah), who will set up a universal kingdom.

Second Reading (2 Cor 5:6-10). St Paul says that his priority at all times is to please the Lord. Hence he has no fears of appearing before him.

Gospel (Mark 4:26-34) This contains two parables about the slow but steady growth of the Kingdom of God from insignificant beginnings. It is God who brings about this growth. Everybody knows that if you plant an acorn in the ground, given time, it will grow into an oak tree. Yet nobody knows how. And how extraordinary that a huge oak should have such humble origins. Jesus says this is how it is with the reign of God in our lives and in our world. It begins in a small way, but given time, it grows into something great. Is this growth happening in my life? Am I growing into a more loving, compassionate, Christ like person?
