

MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

This Sunday's Word of God in brief:

First Reading (Zechariah 12: 10-11) This looks forward to a time when a new spirit will be poured out on the people (as happened at Pentecost), and they will mourn over the one they put to death (namely, Christ).

Second Reading (Gal 3:26-29) Paul states that for those who have been baptized, there must be no more distinctions. Because of Christ all have equal access to the blessings promised to Abraham.

Gospel (Luke 9: 18-24) This tells about Peter's confession of faith in Christ, and how immediately after it Christ told his disciples that he was destined to be rejected and to be put to death. Suffering too awaits all true followers of him.

At a crucial point in his public ministry Christ asked the apostles: 'Who do people say that I am?' The ordinary people had all sorts of false ideas. Only Peter gave the correct answer: 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.' Christ asks the same question of you and me. Let us reflect for a moment to ask ourselves what answer we would give. Who is Christ for me? What does he mean to me? We need the light and grace of God to be able to make the same confession of faith as Peter made.
