Today's Word: This is the feast of Corpus Christi - the Body of Christ. St Paul continually reminds us that we are the Body of Christ. The Eucharist is not a private devotion, it is a great act of common worship. Here we become conscious of our unity. Here the Body of Christ becomes visible. The one thing which above all others would make us unfit to be part of the Eucharist is if we were not reconciled with one another. Are we?

First Reading (Exodus 24:3-8). This reading describes the solemn ratification by Moses and the people of the covenant God made with them on Mount Sinai.

Second Reading (Hebrews 9: 11-15). Through the redeeming work of Christ God has entered into a new and eternal covenant with his people.

Gospel (Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26). This describes the preparation and the celebration of the Passover meal Jesus ate with his disciples the night before he died.
