This weekend's Liturgy of the Word: Today we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the apostles, and how as a result of that coming they went out to preach the Gospel to all the world. It is a mistake to see this coming as something that happened once and that can never happen again. Through the prayer of the Church, the Holy Spirit comes to this roomful of people this morning.

First Reading (Acts 2: 1-11). Here we have an account of the coming of the Holy Spirit on the apostles on Pentecost Day and the effects of that coming on them.

Second Reading (1 Cor. 12:3-7, 12-13). People have different gifts, but it is the same Spirit who gives these various gifts for the building up of the Christian community, which is the Body of Christ.

Gospel (John 20:9-23). On Easter Sunday evening Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit upon his apostles, a Spirit of forgiveness and of peace.
