REFLECTIONS IN BRIEF: First Reading (Deuteronomy 26:4-10). This describes the ceremony of the offering to God of the first fruits. Through it the people recognize all that God has done for them especially in the Exodus. Our worship of God is also a recognition of his favours to us.

Second Reading (Romans 10:8-13) The core of the Christian credo is that Jesus is our risen Saviour. If anyone, Jew or Gentile, can say that and live by it, he or she will be saved. Gospel (Luke 4:1-13). Jesus was tempted like we are but he did not sin. Through his grace we too can resist temptation and over-come sin. We can approach Christ with great confidence that he understands us because, as today's liturgy reminds us, he shared our human weaknesses and temptations. Yet he did not sin. He remained faithful and true to his Father. He will help us who know that we have sinned, to be faithful also.
