Today's Word:

Today the Church invites us to celebrate the mystery of the Trinity. We begin and end each Eucharist with the names of the Father, the Son, and the Spirit on our lips. This is a mystery to be celebrated with childlike love and trust. God is a Father to us; he is a Brother to us; he is a Consoler and Guide to us. This should be the atmosphere in which we live, move, and have our being. Yet we often relegate the father, the Son and the Spirit to the margins of our lives.

First Reading (Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40). Moses reminds the people that the great God of heaven and earth has entered into a close and loving relationship with them. They should respond by doing his will.

Second Reading (Romans 8: 14-17). By the fact that the Holy Spirit dwells within us, we become children of the Father, and coheirs with Christ his Son.

Gospel (Matthew 28: 16- 20). This contains the final instructions of Jesus to his apostles.

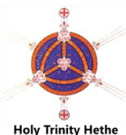
