Often we write off other people on the strength of one bad experience or one unfriendly encounter with them. We rarely give them a second chance, much less a third or a fourth one. However, this is not only silly but downright unfair. Which of us would like to be judged on a single moment of our lives?

We know how badly Peter acted on the night of the Lord's passion; how he denied his Master, not once, but three times. Yet in today's Gospel we will see how Christ restored him to where he was before and confirmed him as chief shepherd of his flock.

First Reading (Acts 5:27-32, 40-41). The apostles have been imprisoned and put on trial because of their preaching of the Gospel. But they are undeterred. In fact they are glad to suffer for Christ.

Second Reading (Rev. 5:11-14). This gives us part of the heavenly liturgies that are a feature of the book of the Apocalypse. It is a hymn in praise of the crucified and risen Christ.

Gospel (John 21:1-19). This relates an appearance of the risen Jesus to seven of his apostles on the shore of the lake of Gennesareth. The incident is built around Peter. God bless you.
