LITURGY OF THE WORD - REFLECTION'S IN BRIEF: Today's liturgy reminds us of one of the greatest truths in the Bible, namely, that there are really only two commandments. The first is to love God, and the second is to love our neighbour. They are not meant to be separated. But we often do separate them. We like to think that we are on good terms with God, yet how many of us can say that we are on good terms with all our neighbours? We speak to God when we pray, but do we speak to all our neighbours?

First Reading (Deut 6:2-6). Moses reminds the people of the great commandment to love God. To love God means to keep his commandments and to walk in his ways.

Second Reading (Hebrews 7:23-28). This reading shows the superiority of Christ over the priests of the Old

Gospel (Mark 12:28-34). All of God's commandments can be reduced to two.
