

Reflections briefly on this weekend's Word of God '

First Reading: (Malachi 3: 19-20) For evil doers the Day of the Lord will be a day of judgement; but for the upright it will be a Day of Salvation.

Second Reading: (2 Thessalonians 3:7-12) As far as possible, each person must try to earn the food that he eats.

Gospel: (Luke 21 :5-19) This foretells the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem. The disciples are warned to beware of false prophets and to be ready to face persecutions of every kind.
