### Reflections briefly on this weekend's Word of God'

*First Reading* (2 Sam 5: 1-3) David had already been anointed King of Judah. Here we read how the northern tribes also acknowledge him as King. Thus David became the King of a united country.

**Second Reading** (Colo. 1:11-20) Paul gives thanks to God for having delivered us from the dominion of darkness and transferred us to the Kingdom of his Son, who is not only head of the Church but head of all creation.

Gospel (Lk 23:35-43) This tells of the mockery Christ suffered as he hung on the cross, and how in the midst of it he brought hope and salvation to one of the thieves crucified with him. Today we honour Christ as our King. We honour him best, however, by helping to spread his Kingdom. We should do this collectively, as members of the Church, and also individually. Christ wants us to be messengers of his love to others, but especially to the poor and the needy. What kind of a messenger am 1?

### Prayer for the Year of Mercy

Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us to be merciful like the heavenly Father, and have told us that whoever sees you sees Him. Show us your face and we will be saved.
