REFLECTIONS: First Reading (Malachi 1: 14-2:2,8-10) The prophet gives the priests of his day a right good telling off because they have shown favouritism, thus causing distinctions and divisions among God's people.

Second Reading (I Thessalonians 2:7-9,13) St Paul reminds the Thessalonians of his love and care for them, and how hard he worked to bring the Good News to them.

Gospel (Matthew 23: 1-12) Jesus launches a very strong attack on the religious leaders, but what he says is important for us too. Jesus had some harsh criticism to make of the scribes and Pharisees. He called them hypocrites, who preached one thing and did another. Which of us can truthfully say that our deeds match our words? Therefore, to some extent, we are all hypocrites. But each time we come to Mass we are called by God to a life of truth and sincerity.
