LITURGY OF THE WORD REFLECTION'S IN BRIEF:

A rich young man of excellent character came to Christ wanting to live a better life. But when Christ told him that if he wished to 'become a disciple of his he would have to give up his wealth, he went away sad. None of us follow Christ as closely as we should. The same thing preventing us from doing so. That same thing is probably different for each one of us. I wonder what it is?

First Reading (Wisdom 7:7-11). This is a passage in praise of wisdom. Wisdom is more precious than gold, or silver, or health, or beauty.

Second Reading (Hebrews 4: 12-13). God's Word is a source of true wisdom for us. It will help us to live as God wants us to live.

Gospel (Mark 10: 17-30). We are presented with the case of a good young man who refuses to follow Christ because he is unwilling to give up his wealth.
