First Reading (Isaiah 45: 1.4-6) The return of the people from exile under King Cyrus is seen not merely as a sign of God's love for his people but of his lordship over all people.

Second Reading (1 Thessalonians 1: 1-5) This contains the opening lines from Paul's first letter to the community of Christians he founded at Thessalonika. His concern for them shines through.

Gospel (Matthew 22: 15-21) In an effort to trap Jesus into saying something incriminating, his enemies ask him whether or not it is right for a Jew to pay taxes to Caesar. Many times as Christians we are faced with difficult decisions. But we have been given an inner voice to guide us, namely, the voice of conscience. How well do we listen to this voice? For instance, am I at peace with my conscience right now?
