LITURGY OF THE WORD REFLECTION'S IN BRIEF:

The readings of today's Mass talk about the bond of love that marriage creates between a man and a woman, a bond that God does not wish to see broken. We come to this Eucharist as isolated individuals. But the Eucharist, properly understood and celebrated, creates a bond of love between us. Christ does not wish to see this bond broken. But unfortunately, through our selfishness and separateness, we often do break it.

First Reading (Genesis 2: 18-24). God made man and woman for each other. The bond of marriage means they are no longer two but one.

Second Reading (Hebrews 2:9-11). By entering fully into human life by experiencing the bitterness of death, Christ became a brother and a Saviour to all people.

Gospel (Mark 10: 2-16) Christ teaches that the marriage bond comes from God and that it is permanent and indissoluble.
