LITURGY OF THE WORD REFLECTION'S IN BRIEF:

We are all very much influenced by what others think and say about us. We all like to be well -thought of by others. There is a danger here. We might make popularity the goal of our lives. And we might forget the only thing that matters - the reality of who and what I am. No matter what others may think of me, God thinks well of me, because I am his child. Each of us can say that. Therefore, let us ask his pardon for our sins, especially those of pride and vanity.

First Reading (Isaiah 50:5-9). This passage talks about the sufferings of the just man whose task it is to teach people the ways of God. He is sustained in all his trials by the firm belief that God is with him.

Second Reading (James 2: 14-18). This contains a very important message, namely, that faith without good works is dead.

Gospel (Mark 8:27-35). Even though Peter declared his belief in Jesus as the Messiah, he had no idea what that implied.
