# This weekend's reflections in brief...

**First Reading** (Wisdom 9: 13-18) Faced with the mysteries of the universe, the meaning of history, and the mind of God, we are ignorant. But God has not

**Second Reading** (Philemon 9-10, 12-17) Philemon was a Colossian, converted by Paul. His slave Onesimus ran away and somehow reached Paul in prison, where he was converted. Paul urges Philemon to take him back, not as a slave, but as a brother.

**Gospel** (Luke 14:25-33) This contains two very short parables dealing with the theme of self-renunciation or the cost of discipleship.

You can measure a person's commitment to a cause by what he or she is prepared to pay for it. We cannot hope to be genuine followers of Christ without making sacrifices and paying a price. What does it mean for me to be a Christian? How does it affect my life? What does it cost me?
