LITURGY OF THE WORD REFLECTION'S IN BRIEF:

In Today's Gospel we hear the story of how Jesus cured a man who was deaf and who had an impediment in his speech. You might say this has no relevance for us, but it has. There are so many important things we are not able to hear, so many important things we are not able to say. This is what sin does. Let us ask Christ to cure our blindness, deafness, and dumbness.

First Reading (Isaiah 35:4-7). The prophet urges those who are losing heart to take courage, for God is coming to vindicate and save his people.

Second Reading (James 2: 1-5). Class distinction should have no place among Christians.

Gospel (Mark 7: 31- 37). This tells how Jesus cured a gentle man who was deaf and who also had an impediment in his speech.
